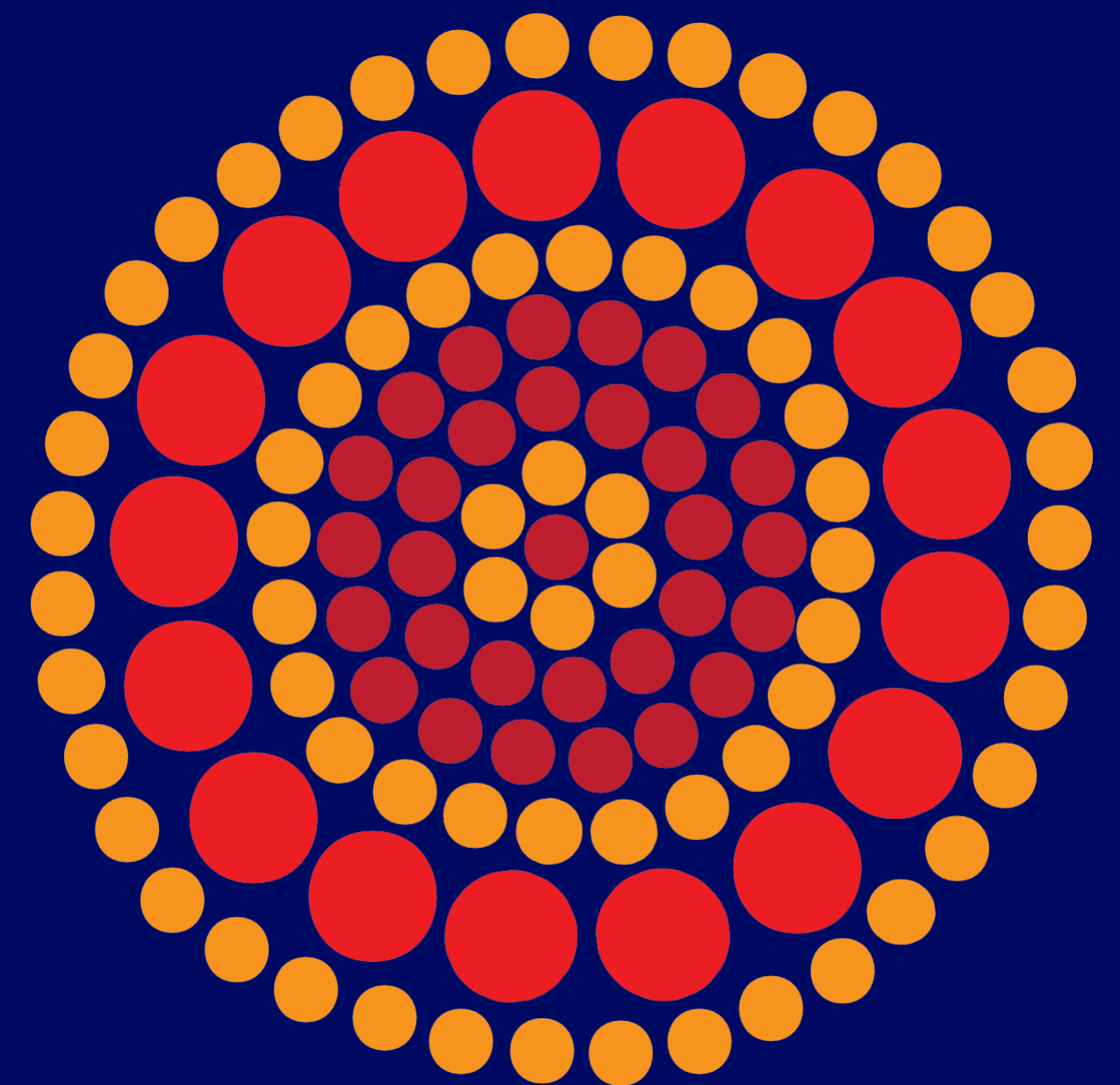

The intent of this library is to provide you with a starting point for a broad range of amazing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and businesses.

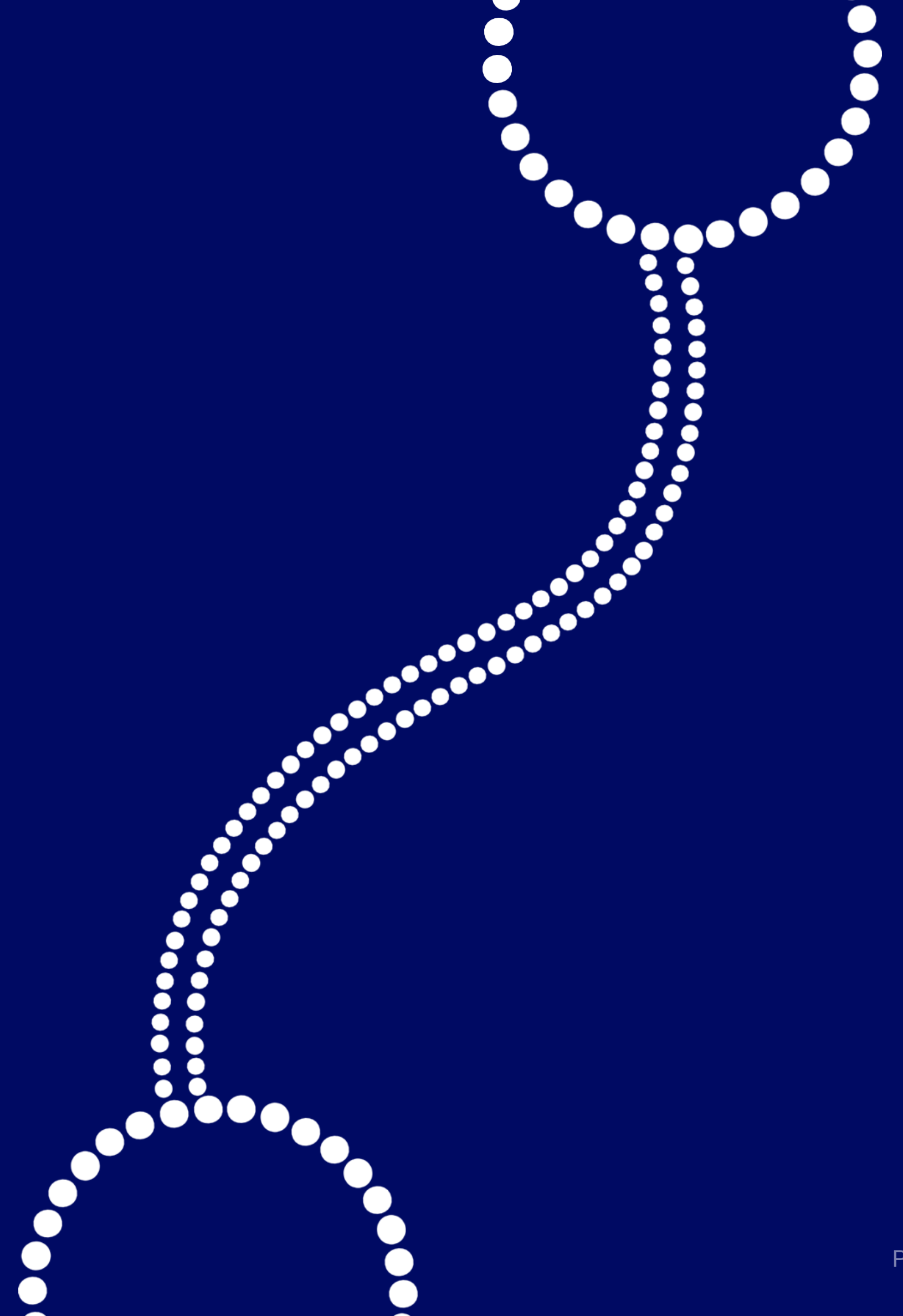
This list has been pulled together by the TMA RAP Committee and is by no means an exhaustive list.
